

Crowns

Ideal for protecting a cracked tooth or covering up discoloration, crowns can be a great solution for improving your smile. A crown is a tooth shaped cap that fits over a problem tooth to improve strength, size and appearance.

The crown procedure is simple:

- First we will anesthetize the area. Once completely numb, the tooth is filed down so that the crown fits appropriately.
- Then, we will take an impression of the tooth to use in the construction of the crown. The impressions are sent away to a dental laboratory to create your crown. Meanwhile, we apply a sturdy temporary crown over the problem tooth while your permanent crown is manufactured.
- Once your permanent crown is ready, you will come back and the crown will be applied. Now you have a bright, healthy-looking new tooth!
